3. **Course Evaluations:** Submit several evaluations for courses taught at the graduate level.
4. **Teaching Philosophy:** Provide a 2–3-page summary of your teaching philosophy. The philosophy should include your purpose for teaching in higher education full time, expectations of students, teaching approach and methodologies used. Also explain your thoughts on teaching to the needs of society today. Include examples, learning experiences, and ideals you have for your students as well as yourself.
5. **References:** Submit the names, titles, addresses, telephone numbers, and e-mail addresses of three people familiar with your academic and professional background who can be contacted concerning your qualifications. Please state their relationship to you; at least one person should be able to speak about your focus on your contributions to the betterment of society.
